Two students are assigned to one trainer at a time. This is to ensure that each student's individual learning needs are met, the dogs we work on are comfortable and safe, and that all of our attention is focused on you!

Our courses are designed to get you where you want to go. That may be into an existing salon, starting up a home-based business that gives you work-life balance, a mobile van or trailer, or even grooming at a vet clinic.







Our 10 day short course is purpose built for those with some existing skills handling dogs. With your handling down pat, picking up grooming skills is a little easier, and that's why we can only offer this course to those who've worked with dogs before. This course is perfect for vet nurses, boarding kennel workers or doggy daycare workers. In 10 days we can teach you how to groom a dog from start to finish safely and gently, and apply some basic styling tips to pet trims. The online component will help your practical skills stick, plus teach you some more of the theoretical side of grooming and canine well-being that groomers need to know.

Heiniger Academy is an RTO that offers a **Certificate III in Animal Care (Pet Grooming)**. The practical grooming component of this course is delivered and assessed by independent Training Centres, of which Dog Diversity is one. Your theory work for Heiniger Academy is completed in your own time, and you attend Dog Diversity for 5 weeks of practical training and assessing.

We recommend commencing your course with Heiniger Academy at least one month in advance to get the best out of the 5 weeks at Dog Diversity.

Certificate III students are responsible for their own videoing and photography, and uploading of the required evidence for the Heiniger Academy coursework, **as well as** Dog Diversity's in-house 4 Week Intensive certification requirements. Please have a thorough understanding of what is involved with Heiniger Academy prior to commencement.

In the unlikely event that you are unable to be deemed competent in all aspects of practical grooming during the 5 Week Practicum, you will be offered the opportunity to return to Dog Diversity for additional assessment when you have gained more experience in the dog grooming industry. Additional assessments are charged at \$195 per dog, and you will have to supply your own appropriate dog for the session.

Completion of the 5 Week Practicum will also award you the Dog Diversity Professional Dog Groomer Certificate, provided all Dog Diversity's online coursework is completed to our standard.

What about equipment?

Yes, you'll need some!

When you register for the course, we will ask you to indicate your equipment choices.

HIRE

We can hire you a kit for \$100 fee + \$400 bond. At the end of the course you will receive your \$400 bond back, provided all is well.

PURCHASE

You may wish to purchase your own equipment for the course. We can supply you with what you need in a handy case of you own. We recommend purchasing your kit in advance so you can mark all your gear with a unique identifier - nail polish works well! Or use an engraver. There are three purchase options, outlined in further detail on sign up.



BYO

You can BYO the scissors and blades you'll need. All the details are in the sign-up form when you register and enrol.



How do I enrol & pay

PAYMENTS AND SCHEDULES

After you've registered for your course, you will be sent an invoice outlining the payment timeline for your fees.

GROOMERS ASSISTANT COURSE | \$3,995

DEPOSIT: \$650 due on enrolment to hold your place. 1st payment of \$1545 is due one week before your scheduled start date. 2nd payment \$1800 is due at the end of week 1.

10 DAY SHORT COURSE | \$4,295

DEPOSIT: \$650 due on enrolment to hold your place. 1st payment of \$1,645 is due one week before your scheduled start date. 2nd payment of \$2000 is due at the end of week 1.

4 WEEK GROOMING INTENSIVE | \$7,995 MOST POPULAR

DEPOSIT: \$650 due on enrolment to hold your place.

1st payment of \$2,345 is due one week before your scheduled start date.

2nd and 3rd payments of \$2,500 are due in Week 1 and Week 3 of your course respectively.

5 WEEK PRACTICUM ACM30122 | \$9,795

DEPOSIT: \$950 due on enrolment to hold your place.

1st PAYMENT \$2845 is due one week before your scheduled start date.

2nd and 3rd payments of \$3000 are due in Week 1 and Week 3 of your course respectively.

Our Cancellation and Refund Policy is available in the registration form and reflects that we keep our class sizes small and carefully budget our operations in order for that to be possible. Please note that make-up days are charged at \$450 per day and are subject to avaiability.

Frequently asked questions

Do you have accommodation options?

If you need somewhere to stay for your course, try Airbnb. There's a few good options <u>on</u> <u>our website</u> that are walking distance to us.

Can I study part time?

In order to learn to groom successfully, you need to give your body time to develop muscle memory. It is for this reason that we only offer full time training courses. A 4 Week Program will get you well on your way to developing your grooming techniques. In order to keep developing and strengthening these techniques, we recommend you have either volunteer work or grooming employment lined up after the course.

Is the 4 Week Intensive a TAFE Course?

No. Dog Diversity is a private training school. On completion of our 4 Week Intensive course you will be issued an in-house Certificate of Professional Dog Grooming. If we deem more study and practice is necessary, a Certificate of Participation will be issued.

Do I enrol with you first or <u>Heiniger Academy</u> first if I want to complete the Certificate III in Animal Care (Pet Grooming)?

It's best to claim your spot at Dog Diversity first, as places are limited and fill fast.

Do you have a concession price? Can I get government funding for these courses?

As we are a private training school, unfortunately we have no access to any government funding or concessions to pass on to students, even for the Certificate III.
